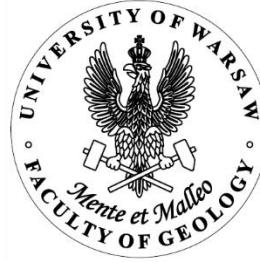

**Requirements for candidates:**

- PhD with habilitation degree in Earth Sciences in the field of geology,
- experience in researching and developing of rock mechanics,
- ability to interpret of uniaxial and triaxial laboratory investigation results,
- reveal active participation in scientific conferences and confirmed leadership of scientific project manager,
- documented achievements in the applying geomechanics in hydrocarbon exploration,
- skills in laboratory methods of measurements of geometric structures of joints and ability to determine of roughness parameters for rock mass classifications.
- teaching experience in conducting classes in the field of geomechanics and rock engineering,
- experience in conducting diploma theses in the field of geomechanics,
- participation in national and international scientific conferences
- knowledge of Polish and English languages.

**Main duties:**

- conducting of scientific activities and particular investigations in the field of rock mechanics,
- conducting of didactic activities in the field of rock engineering, geomechanics, rock mechanics,
- conducting of organizational activities,
- conducting of diploma works.

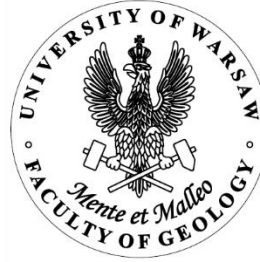
**The candidates should submit:**

1. application addressed to the Rector of the University of Warsaw containing consent "I give permission to the University of Warsaw, registered at the address of ul. Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28, 00-927 Warszawa, to process my personal data for the purposes of carrying out the recruitment procedure, choosing the employee, and entering into an employment contract with the University of Warsaw, if applicable. I have been informed about my legal rights and obligations in relation to these actions. I acknowledge that providing the aforementioned personal data is done by me on a voluntary basis. "
2. a diploma or equivalent document confirming the achievement of a degree;
3. opinion of an independent researcher;
4. list of publications;
5. Information about previous employment;
6. motivation letter;

Applications will be considered by the Faculty Recruitment Commission. The Faculty reserves the right to answer only selected offers and to close the competition without selecting a candidate.

The contest will be settled before than October 30, 2020

This contest is the first stage of the employment procedure of the academic staff, specified in the Statute of the UW. Its positive result will initiate further stages of the employment procedures. The competition is open to persons who meet the requirements set in forth in the Act on Higher Education of July 20, 2018 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws 2020, item 85, as amended)
